Rare medium talks

AUSTRALIA'S own "Ghost Whisperer" is on his way to Busselton for a special seminar at the Abbey Beach Resort next week to communicate with the dead, pass on their messages and teach the audience the art behind "soul talking".

Anthony Grzelka told the Busselton Margaret River Times he had been communicating with the dead professionally for about four or five years after his first run-in with spirits and the supernatural as a child.

"At the time they came quite naturally. I used to see spirits, get thoughts and emotions that weren't mine," Grzelka said. "Of course now I know what it is."

Grzelka said anyone can communicate with those who have passed through life and beyond, however he had mastered the art through practise and a lot of hard work.

"It comes naturally to everyone, it's not exclusive to me," he explained. "The difference between myself and someone who doesn't do it is I'm a bit more turned on, I practise.

"Through meditation and focus exercises I can isolate thoughts and feelings that aren't mine — that's the really important part, to isolate those from your own conscious thoughts."

Unlike many who delve into the

supernatural world of channeling spirits and talking to dead people, Grzelka encourages an amount of scepticism from his audience.

"People should be sceptical. A lot of people in this field don't know what they're doing," he said.

"It's important to be somewhat sceptical, but don't be cynical.

"Be open to the fact that this is a possibility — when it happens to you, you'll realise."
